Federation of State Medical Board's Uniform Application Requirements





The Uniform Application for Licensure (UA) is a web-based application designed to improve license portability by eliminating the need for physicians, physician assistants (PAs) and resident applicants to re-enter information when applying for licenses in multiple states. In addition to completing the UA, verification of documents related to identity, education, training and more is an important part of the overall licensure process. Many state medical boards accept the use of the Federation Credentials Verification Service (FCVS) for credentials verification. In fact, several boards accually require this service.
